WELCOME TO YOUR SUMMER YOUTH CHALLENGE

WHAT IS IT?

'We are Cork Summer Youth Challenge' is a series of exciting, fun challenges for young people to complete throughout the summer of 2020. There is a variety of challenges to choose from, all of which are non-competitive. Using the Flipgrid App (Download from App Store), pick 20 challenges from the list, have fun and be creative with them and create a short video of you completing your challenge.

While this is a non-competitive challenge, we encourage all young people to participate to the best of their ability and engage positively with the challenges set for them. Have fun and be as creative as possible while also taking the opportunity to develop new and exciting skills.

Why not try to push yourself a little further than you have before?

WHO IS IT FOR?

The challenge is designed for young people 13-18 years from across Cork City and County.

HOW DO I SIGN UP?

1. REGISTER

Register for the Challenge by clicking link here or at www.corkcity.ie All that will be required is to have a parent/guardian to fill in consent section of registration form.

2. CONFIRM

You will receive an acknowledgement email to confirm your registration and with your Challenge access Code.

3. DOWNLOAD

Download FlipGrid App on your phone/tablet or log onto www.flipgrid.com and sign in using your access code from email. This will be used to create an online personal portfolio of all your challenges.

4. EXPLORE

Explore the Grid, check out the challenges – We would ask that you complete the 'Welcome to your challenge' task first to let us know who you are.

5. DECIDE

Decide which challenges you would like to complete and start making short clips completing them for your portfolio (See FlipGrid YouTube channel). Each p articipant is asked to complete at least 20 challenges – You can always complete more than this and enjoy the fun.

6. COMPLETE

When you have completed your 20 challenges – Complete the 'Final Round Up' challenge. This is the wrap up for us to get your certificate and medal ready.





USING FLIPGRID

We have chosen to use FlipGrid as the preferred platform for the challenge. It has a social media type interface, but is not a public platform, only visible to those taking part. Check out the various topics and you will be able to share your short video responses.

To get started check out simple video here.

Once you have the App downloaded and access code entered start exploring your challenges. It's as simple as click on the challenge you wish to complete. All the challenges have links and guides for you to get more information and signposts. The App allows you to upload video evidence of your challenge. Be creative – show a video collage, a video voice over, it could be a video diary or interviews, maybe a blog or a podcast? It's your platform, your voice!

Click the large green/white + button to begin recording and sharing your voice and challenge. Use the Emojis', doodles and other tools to make your video stand out. Throughout the challenge you can delete and resubmit your video if you wish. Your video now becomes part of your portfolio for the challenge. You are now on your way to receiving your medal.

Upon completion of challenges, participants will be awarded a special Medal from the Lord Mayor of Cork and the County Mayor along with a certificate of completion.

All information gathered on registration is private and will not be shared with any 3rd Parties. All young people ages 18 or under are required to have parent/guardian permission to participate. All Videos and information shared on the FlipGrid are posted to a private platform for the purpose of the challenge.

Videos and posts will be monitored on a daily basis by the challenge co-ordinators all who are employees of the partner organisations.

Any videos/data that is posted that is deemed to inappropriate will be reviewed by the challenge co-ordinators and contact will be made with the participant and parent/guardian.
