

National Voter Registration Day

30th of April



Every resident aged 18 or over, regardless of nationality, can apply for inclusion on the Electoral Register. It takes just a few minutes to submit your details online through www.CheckTheRegister.ie

Depending on your nationality/citizenship, you will qualify for specific electoral events (see below).

If you are already on the register but have recently become Irish by way of naturalisation, then you can update same by submitting an [ERF1 Update form](#).

Those aged 16 and 17 can pre-register online and will be automatically added to the register when they turn 18.

Voter eligibility is based on citizenship as it appears on the Electoral Register:

- **Irish:** All elections & referendums
- **EU Citizen:** European & Local elections
- **British Citizen:** Dáil & Local elections
- **All Other:** Local elections

Important information required when applying online via www.CheckTheRegister.ie :

- First time applicants should select **I'm not registered**
- If you are updating your details (new address etc) select **I'm already registered**
- PPSN (required for identity verification)
- Date of Birth
- First Name
- Surname
- Nationality
- Eircode
- Address
- Email
- Contact Number (optional)
